CROATIAN TRADITION

Enology and viticulture in Croatia has a long tradition. They are distributed in almost all parts of the country, and wine culture is part of the traditional way of life. Although the vines on Croatian soil were presented much earlier, the oldest artifact that proves wine-growing and wine production dates back to the 5th century BC.

Phoenicians and Greeks brought the first cuttings of vine to the Adriatic coast. The mild climate in the area of coastal Croatia, the sea wealth, fertile land of many fields and bays on islands and coastal areas accounted our country to be attractive for settlement and cultivation of wines. Phoenicians as traders in Istria and then the Greeks with the establishment of "policy" in Dalmatia such as Korčyra nigra - Black Korčula, Issa - Vis, Pharos - Hvar, are most responsible for the cultivation of vines in coastal Croatia.

In the continental part of Croatia wine trade arrived several centuries later. It was partly spread by Illyrians and Thracians, but the most responsible for its spreading were the Romans. Due to the exceptional vineyard locations and excellence, wine of Pannonia, today Slavonia, competed with the best wines of the Apennine peninsula and the Old World. The name that the Romans assigned "Vallis Aurea" or "Golden Valley" indicates what kind of vineyards we are talking about.

Croatia can be divided into two wine-growing regions. These are coastal and continental, with additional sub-regions that each of them has. Croatia has more than 100 different indigenous varieties, but we are faced with the disappearance of a large number of them. Nevertheless, many winemakers are turning to the revitalization and cultivation of old varieties and we will certainly support that. As this is our life, our duty and responsibility, our heritage, our tradition!

Croatian Sparkling Wines

Sparkling wines in Croatia are produced in almost all regions. On the one hand we have sparkling wines from moderately hilly landscapes with colder climate and on the other hand there are wines from extremely sunny continental and Mediterranean areas. More terroir ... more different sparkling wines. With a balanced sun hours and rainfalls, cooler regions certainly have more ideal conditions for sparkling wines. They are permeated with more freshness and excellent quality. In addition to the famous international or autochthonous varieties used, winemakers also use the traditional method in production.

Croatian White Wines

...almost two thirds of Croatian wine production goes in favor of white wines. Croatia contains all five possible wine-growing zones which are determined by the temperature and the number of sun hours...

ADRIATIC CROATIA

Dalmatia

First regulations on viticulture in Dalmatia and its islands were written already in 13th century. The most extensive one and composed in 8 books, Dubrovnik Statute, and some of its rules apply even today. Dalmatia is ... "the main vault" of indigenous Croatian varieties... starting from the island of Pag, Šibenik, our other islands and Dubrovnik region.

Mediterranean climate and a greater number of sun hours produce white wines that are naturally aromatic, with fruity notes, stronger body and long-lasting. With many varieties like Vugava, Bogdanuša, Debit, Rukatac, Zlatica, we especially recommend the island of Korčula and Konavle vineyards. As in the past, these areas give the best selection of Croatian white wines even today. Pošip and Grk from Korčula and Dubrovačka Malvasija from Konavle are the most common varieties of this region.

POŠIP is the first Croatian white wine, with protected geographical origin. With its full and distinctive flavor, aromatic notes and moderate acid, it fits perfectly with all fish, shellfish and white meat dishes. Pošip comes as a fresh and young wine or the aged one, with full and rounded body.

GRK is variety that is, by its cultivation, closely linked to the island of Korčula, more precisely to the position of Lumbarda. A sandy soil makes this wine a distinct and special variety, so it is of a dry character, harmonious and rounded with beautiful mineral value. It can be paired with all seafood specialties. A special terroir and freshness give it the possibility of aging.

MALVASIJA DUBROVAČKA is a precious wine of Dubrovnik Republic with a long history, celebrated and recorded hundreds of times. Gentle and sensitive for breeding it comes as dry or dessert wine. Due to its muscati pleasant aromas and nicely incorporated freshness this wine goes perfectly with light dishes and seafood specialties.

ADRIATIC CROATIA

Istria & Kvarner

As in Dalmatia, wine is now an inseparable part of Istria identity. The largest Adriatic peninsula has a sub-Mediterranean climate and the diversity of the soil in vineyards offers a large wine selection. Although a number of international wines (Chardonnay, Pinot Blanc, Sauvignon Blanc, etc.) have been grown in Istria, Istrian Malvazija and Muscat Momjanski are the two most important indigenous white varieties.

MALVAZIJA is a dry wine, with pronounced aroma, and it comes fresh and young but also more often aged, full or ready for aging.

MUSCAT is a wine of sweet aroma, gentle notes, mostly young and lively wine.

The island of Krk is famous for its authentic variety **ŽLAHTINA** which is a light wine with fruit aromas.

CONTINENTAL CROATIA

Continental Croatia is characterized by cold winters and hot summers. Some sub-regions are significantly cooler than e.g. Slavonia, and therefore in the western areas white aromatic varieties such as Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay, Riesling and Muscat are successfully grown... Zagorje, sub-region which is yet further north, is considered to be one of the world's best terroir for predicate wines. Although sometimes forgotten, indigenous varieties are widespread and many winemakers return to our roots ...in St. Ivan Zelina we have Kraljevina and in Moslavina Škrlet on Plešivica old varieties...

However, the two most important white varieties of Continental Croatia are Graševina and Traminac.

GRASEVINA is the most widely spread Croatian grape variety. Although its relationship with various European varieties such as Welschriesling has been mentioned in the famous encyclopaedia " Wine Grapes' by Jancis Robinson, it is classified under the autochthonous Slavonia varieties .

Grasevina literally derives from a comparison with peas because of the berries before the maturation stage, but this variety gives wine of wonderful fruit flavors, moderate alcohol and with usual mild bitterness at the end as its variety characteristics. Also, Grasevina late harvests are considered to be a unique predicate.

TRAMINAC or better yet Royal Traminac! Although not authentic, has found the best soil and climate conditions in the most eastern Croatian territory around the town of Ilok.

Roundness, its sweet notes, pronounced Muscat flavor, elder flower and in the best of predicates, honey aromas, are the reason why this wine is drunk as the only wine of this region to the British Royal Court.

In 1953, this wine was drunk to celebrate the coronation of Queen Elizabeth II, and soon, the guests of Prince Harry's wedding will sweeten their palate with this sweet predicate nectar from 1947.

Croatian Red Wines

Although the white, indigenous varieties are more numerous, red wine in Croatia deserves special attention. They are the most common in the coastal zone but it certainly does not mean that the continental part has no excellent red wines. Climatic conditions and already mentioned differences between our wine-growing regions, offer a unique wine selection. From light young wine to the full body aged wine... everyone will find what they prefer the most...

ADRIATIC CROATIA

Dalmatia

This is the most southern Croatian region with the extremely sunny Mediterranean climate. Dalmatia abounds with excellent red wines. By their structure Dalmatian wines are rich and delicious, with full body, pronounced but nicely polished tannins, long-lasting and most ready when aged. The most important red variety in Dalmatia and also Croatia is Plavac Mali. This variety has a long and interesting history. It was founded about 250 years ago, crossed between two varieties, Dobričić from the island of Solta and Tribidraga around Kastela hinterland. Today this variety is world famous for one very important fact. "Father" of Plavac Mali, the sort Tribirag or, in our region, referred to as Crljenak Kaštelanski, Pribidrag, the Mediterranean Primitivo, Tribidragho is a sounding world name, but not so much sounded as when pronounced as Zinfandel. This is variety of the Imperial State Nursery in Vienna imported into the United States (Long Island) in the early twenties of the 19th century. Our famous Californian winemaker Miljenko Mike Grgić, has been talking about the great similarity between Plavac Mali and Zinfandel for ages. Of course, it was impossible to prove and confirm anything without actual scientific evidence. With the development of the science of genetics and new approaches with DNA analysis, it was finally proved what has been believed for a long time. The famous professor and scientist from California, Carole Meredith, is the most responsible for the proof that Zinfandel or Primitivo is Croatia's indigenous variety that bears the original name Tribidrag. Plavac Mali and Zinfandel are therefore closely linked and have the same roots.

Due to phylloxera and large vine extinction in our area, Zinfandel has almost disappeared and only a few vines, found in forgotten vineyards, were enough to encourage the re-production and story of this Croatian wine.

PLAVAC MALI is grown in all parts of Dalmatia. The islands of Hvar, Brač and the Pelješac peninsula are positions of a unique terroir. Wines from these regions have the best quality.

DINGAČ and **POSTUP** are two appellations of the utmost importance and these are the first two protected wine and terrain appellations in Croatia. Due to the micro-climate conditions in these positions, one part of Plavac Mali's grape goes into over-ripeness stage, up to almost 30% of the dried berries and yields are unique, just between whopping 400g - 1kg per vine. The wines are special and well known, and increased sugar content in the wine gives them a unique flavor. Dry or semi-dry, these wines are harmonious and full-bodied, with robust and pleasant tannic structure and over the years they become increasingly better.

Plavac Mali and Zinfandel are not the only Dalmatian varieties. Another big wine is worth of attention.

BABIĆ is situated around the area of Primošten. This is a grape that grows "from stone". Hardened land is surrounded by stone walls to keep what is left of it from washing out. Although extremely sunny area Babić, unlike Plavac Mali, has a high acidity and it fits fantastically with more alcohol and ripe tannins. These are the wines that can be aged.

ADRIATIC CROATIA

Istria & Kvarner

Combination of soil, climate and terrain is the reason that the Istrian wines are of exceptional quality. Unlike Dalmatia, moderate Mediterranean climate and cold winters give noticeable freshness and minerality to wines and also give medium to full-bodied wines. Along the shoreline matured wine with dominant fruity aromas prevail, while those from inside are more vibrant and richer in freshness. Istria has many international varieties. This terrain is successful for Bordeaux blends and monosort wines from Cabernet Sauvignon, Pinot Noir, Merlot, Refosco and others. Although the most common variety in this region is Merlot, our indigenous variety Teran is one that deserves the greatest attention.

TERAN is an old Istrian indigenous variety that was first mentioned more than 600 years ago. It gives a moderate to strong wine, with deep red color with purple reflections, fine and pronounced flavor recognizable for Teran, and fruity character dominated by the taste of raspberries, cherries or sour cherries. Due to its characteristics it perfectly blends with meat dishes and cheese.

CONTINENTAL CROATIA



Although the central part of Croatia is better known for the production of white still wines and sparkling wines, it is certainly rich in excellent red wines. The colder climate and mountainous terrain of individual sub-regions have an exceptional terroir for lighter body red varieties. Pinot Noir from Pleševica vineyard, Merlot from Slavonia or Cabernet Sauvignon from Zagorje, are wines of exceptional quality. Unique natural Pleševica amphitheatres or sunny Slavonia valley give wines of world quality. In certain years, some terrains of Slavonia counted more sunshine hours than our islands. The wines are then rich and full, rounded, with higher alcohol but very consistent and harmonious. Continental Croatia wines are by their nature mostly permeated with more conspicuous freshness, lighter to medium full body, pleasant aromas and ready for aging.

They date from the time of wine production beginnings and originate most likely from Georgia, one of the cradles of winemaking.

If we simplify, we can say that these are macerated white wines, produced similar as red wines but with prolonged contact between grapes and wine.

Such a thing is nothing "new" or fad in wine world, but returning back to the beginning of winemaking. Some winemakers raised it to the level of organic or biodimic farming.

Although aging can take place in different materials, production from the urn called "amfora" is extremely rare and unique.

Aged Under the Sea

Tradition is strong in the winemaking but time showed us that every generation has pioneers eager to try something new and different.

Winemakers themselves were always looking for innovative and unique ways of making wines and when it comes to aging, the way they do it is endless.

Even if the first experiments with underwater aging dates already in 2003. an important finding made a huge interest years later.

In 2010. 168 bottles of likely the world's oldest Champagne, had been found beneath the Baltic Sea. Claiming that nearly two hundred years old wine was in "exquisite" conditions, it was sold for the highest price ever.

The underwater "close to perfect" conditions have a merit of their own. Total darkness, constant temperature and currents that gently rock the bottles, add complexity to the wine.

The wine ages differently underwater and atmospheric pressure accelerate the aging process.
